VIÀCH | VINEYARD

Viàch is a Müller-Thurgau that matures in the midday sun. The vineyard is a hymn to peasant ingenuity and tenacity. Recovered with a mallet and pickaxe from the mountain, it is a continuum of terraces and dry-stone walls that follow the twisted course of the ridge. It is the mountain that becomes a vineyard: the rows of vines, dense, serrated, never linear, weave a tailor-made dress over it.

VIÀCH | WINE

An ecosystem in its own right, close to 700 m asl, with deep, sandy, well-drained soils, originating from the disintegration of porphyritic rocks, give the wine a freshness and persistence.

A pleasant place, like the aromas of its wine, reminiscent of white flowers such as lily of the valley and jasmine and fresh mountain fruit such as Renetta apples and Kaiser pears.

VIÀCH | VINIFICATION

Manual harvesting in the second ten days of September, soft pressing in an inert atmosphere, static decantation of the must, fermentation at controlled temperature in stainless steel tanks, lees aging for about 8 months before bottling, bottle-ageing for about 6 months before selling.
